Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) Guide

What is HHW?

Household hazardous waste (HHW) materials are banned from the garbage and should not be placed down the drain or in the natural environment. HHW products can be identified by their hazardous labels and can be flammable, corrosive, explosive, or toxic. While the Mayne Island Recycling Depot accepts some HHW items, other items need to be taken to other off-island facilities for safe disposal.

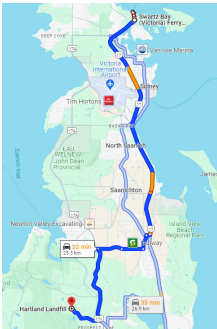
These HHW items are NOT accepted at the Mayne Island Depot

• Household paint	• Aerosol paint	• Wood and metal stains	• Varnish
• Empty oil cans	• Household batteries	• Battery operated appliances	• Cigarette lighters
• Cell phones	• Fluorescent tubes	• Fire starting lighters	• Smoke detectors
